My family has resided and worked in Wickham Market for a very long time now and also as land owners on the outskirts and within Wickham Market are very interested in this plan.

In our view the parish boundary makes perfect sense as a starting point for a comprehensive future plan of development. We feel it is a great shame that neighbouring parishes do not wish to be involved as a plan integrating the surrounding villages has enhanced benefits for all concerned. The surrounding villages will not have their best interests served if they are not involved.
