Further to a request from John Selby I am sending my comments on the neighbourhood boundary consultation. My previous e-mail refers to the local plan issues.

In reponse to the neighbourhood plan boundary consultation. I would like to express my support for the Woodbridge application. As a resident of the area in question, I feel more part of Woodbridge than Martlesham and the areas of California, Dukes Park and Sandy Lane included in the plan are a logical part of Woodbridge and clearly define the physical built boundary of Woodbridge. I further support the view that any development should not extend the physical boundary of Woodbridge and that there should not be a coalesence of the built environement between Woodbridge and Martlesham. I think it is important that both Martlesham and Woodbridge work closely together to ensure that this does not happen regardless of the outcome of the boundary consultation. The land south of Duke's park provides a clear boundary between Martlesham and Woodbridge and should not be developed. Any developement here would not only join Woodbridge and Martlesham but would also form continuous housing from Woodbridge, into Martlesham and Ipswich. This would have a significant impact on the nature and character of Woodbridge. There is also not the infrastructure in terms of road capacity and schools to support further development here especially as there is already significant development in martlesham on the sire adjacent to tescos and the potential adastral park developemnt.

I would be grateful if you would acknowledge receipt of my response to the consultation and ensure that I receive updates on the progress with the Local Plan and the consideration of the above.
