Phase 3.5 East Anglia One North and East Anglia Two offshore wind farms

We are writing with reference to the current additional phase of public consultation on the above mentioned offshore windfarms.

It is appreciated that this is an additional phase which needs to be completed prior to a phase four consultation in the New Year. However, for residents of Leiston and Sizewell, this is their first opportunity to comment upon the possible siting of onshore infrastructure in their town.

Understandably, there have been concerns raised at every public meeting so far and direct to the District and County Councils with regards to the length of time proposed. Mindful of your ongoing requirements and next stage of consultation in the New Year, we would respectfully request that you extend the current time period for consultation by two weeks to give a total of six weeks public consultation which would help our constituents (and ourselves) to respond in a more fulsome manner.

I trust that you can review your current timescales and provide this additional two weeks consultation time for the benefit of all residents in the consultation area.
