## 6 **Sizewell C Programme Update**

- i. Usual project activity halted during Stage 1
- ii. Second Community Forum meeting took place last month

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- iii. Main issues raised by Community – Transport and Accommodation
- iv. Next Forum meets in March
- v. Officers met in tri-partite meeting on 17<sup>th</sup> January 2013. Clear that authorities need to reach agreement on key items ahead of submission
- vi. PINs clear that when reach exam stage public consultation is over
- vii. LA's stressed to EDF need for intermediate consultation on specific areas not properly addressed at Stage 1 (cannot wait until Stage 2) e.g. Transport; Jetty; Rail; Coastal Impacts
- viii. Hinckley – PINS recommendations now gone to Secretary of State
- ix. Secretary of State final decision by 19<sup>th</sup> March 2013
- x. Final Investment Decision delayed until the New Year
- xi. Reactor Design now fully approved by GDS
- xii. Hitachi ABWR design not started GDA (Anglesey & Gloucs sites)
- xiii. Agreement nearly reached with Government on CfD & funded decomm plan
