- vii. LA's stressed to EDF need for intermediate consultation on specific areas not properly addressed at Stage 1 (cannot wait until Stage 2) e.g. Transport; Jetty; Rail; Coastal Impacts
- viii. Hinckley PINS recommendations now gone to Secretary of State
- ix. Secretary of State final decision by 19th March 2013
- x. Final Investment Decision delayed until the New Year
- xi. Reactor Design now fully approved by GDS
- xii. Hitachi ABWR design not started GDA (Anglesey & Gloucs sites)
- xiii. Agreement nearly reached with Government on CfD & funded decomm plan
