3	Sizewell C Update –
	Briefing note updated members on acceptance of the DCO by the Planning Inspectorate and details of the Section 56 engagement period to run from 8 July until 30 September 2020.
4	Bradwell B Briefing Note - Lisa Chandler (Energy Projects Manager ESC).  Briefing note and draft response to EDF Energy's Bradwell B Stage 1 consultation had been circulated. A brief discussion regarding the railway network between lpswich and London took place, there are ongoing meetings to discuss the rail
	network in East Anglia with Network Rail and EDF Energy.

A briefing note had been circulated in advance of the meeting, including a copy of the Councils draft comments on Relevant Representations submitted to the Examining Authority.

The Examining Authority is currently considering submissions and draft Statements of Common Ground. The start of the examination phase is still unconfirmed, but unlikely to be before August.

The Councils completed and submitted an online questionnaire to the Examining Panel with regards to the possibility of virtual hearings. Both Councils are continuing to talk to SPR in relation to draft Statements of Common Ground.

There are ongoing discussions with regards to the A1094/A12 junction and any necessary mitigation required by virtue of the impacts of the projects on this junction.

A question was raised regarding the next steps planned for Sizewell C?

Officers currently assessing the submission in preparation for drafting the Councils' Relevant Representations, to be discussed at Cabinet Meetings of each of the Councils in September. , To inform the Councils' position, the Councils are organizing an event for Town and Parish Councilors the end of July – invites to go out shortly.

Concerns were raised with regards to ongoing unresolved issues at Wickham Market. Steve Merry (Transport Policy and Development Manager, SCC) advised that discussions with EDF Energy and Wickham Market Parish Council are ongoing and that EDF Energy is carrying out further work to inform those discussions.
