Sizewell C update to JLAG members, July 2021

DCO Examination Period

The Examination formally commenced on 15th April 2021 following two Preliminary Meetings. The Examination period is due to run for 6 months from this date, ending on 14th October 2021. The Examining Authority (ExA) have not currently identified any requirement to extend the Examination period beyond this date (however, as with the recent Scottish Power Renewables EA1N and EA2 Examination, we acknowledge that there is always that possibility).

Deadline 4 (1 July 2021)

This deadline was introduced in to the DCO Examination calendar by the ExA after the Examination had started. This provided an additional opportunity for the Applicant to respond to any further information requested by the ExA. Only a relatively small number of technical papers were submitted at this additional deadline.

Minor Changes Consultation (11 June - 12 July 2021)

Due to SZC Co.'s on-going engagement efforts and design refinements, a range of 'minor changes' to the DCO application have been proposed. A public consultation was held in June/July 2021 on the proposed changes prior to the Applicant submitting a formal request to the ExA to accept the changes as part of the DCO process. SZC Co. confirmed that the proposed changes would not result in any new or materially different 'likely significant effects' on the environment from those already presented in the most up to date Environmental Statement (ES).

The proposed minor changes were in relation to the following:

- Lover's Lane and Main Development Site Access Works (including a minor change to Bridleway 19 and relocation of Pegasus crossing, the removal of trees from the tree belt adjacent to Bridleway 19, and repositioning of the mammal culvert);
- Two Village Bypass (including changes to flood relief culverts, removal of a proposed upgrade for PRoW to bridleway, and a change to the PRoW at Friday Street roundabout);
- Sizewell Link Road (including changes to the Pretty Road bridge, becoming a vehicular bridge, changes to ensure the PRoW provides safe crossing, revisions to drainage designs to allow gravity drainage, highway works at B1122 Brown's Plantation, B1122/25 link, Hawthorn Road, Middleton Moor roundabout and minor revisions to the limits of deviation).

SCC and ESC have submitted a response to the consultation; in general, neither Council had particular concerns about the changes, and the responses were of a very technical nature.

Water supply - new change consultation

In SZC Co's Deadline 5 submission, it is noted that the proposed new potable water transfer main by Northumbrian Water Limited won't now be available until December 2024 at the earliest. This is approximately 2 years after the assumed start of construction. Therefore, SZC Co. proposes a temporary desalination plant to meet the project's potable water needs for part of the construction period before the transfer main is available.

As this necessitates a change to the application for development consent, SZC Co will publicly consult on that change during August, before submitting a change application. Issue Specific Hearings (6-16 July 2021)

Issue Specific Hearings were held by the ExA over the course of 8 days in July. The views of the Councils were each represented by Legal Counsel, at the direction of supporting Technical Officers. The hearings covered the draft DCO and Section 106, Traffic and Transport, Socio-economic and Community, Landscape and Visual Impact, Coastal Geomorphology, Biodiversity and Ecology. Each Hearing provided Interested Parties (IPs) with an opportunity to air any views or concerns that they may have in relation to the specific topic area, in response to the pre-determined questions set by the ExA.

Deadline 6 (6 August 2021)

This deadline provides an opportunity for further submission materials and comments to be received by the ExA for consideration as part of the DCO Examination. This includes comments on the Applicant's revised draft DCO, comments on any revised/updated SoCG, comments on Written Representations received at Deadline 5 from additional Interested Parties, Interested Parties and additional affected persons, an updated NPS tracker, Navigation Document, an updated Book of Reference and Schedule of Changes to the Book of Reference (BoR), an updated Statement of Reasons

(SoR) Appendix B 'Status of Negotiations with Owners of the Order Land', an updated SoR Appendix C 'Status of Negotiations with Statutory Undertakers', comments on any additional information/submissions received by Deadline 5 and responses to any further information requested by the ExA for this Deadline.

Compulsory Acquisition Hearings (17-20 August 2021)

Compulsory Acquisition Hearings (CAH) are being held because the application includes a request for an Order granting development consent to authorise Compulsory Acquisition (CA) of land or CA of an interest in or right over land.
