Non Material Change Application to East Anglia Three Development Consent Order 2017

This letter is joint response from Suffolk County Council and East Suffolk Council in relation to the publication in the East Anglian Daily Times of the submission by East Anglia Three Limited of an application for a non material change to East Anglia Three Offshore Wind Farm Order 2017.

The non material change application seeks the following amendments to the Development Consent Order granted in 2017:

- 1. Change in the maximum generating capacity from 1200mw to 1400mw;
- 2. Removal of upper limit for individual wind turbine generator capacity;
- 3. Introduction of a new requirement limiting the number of gravity base foundations to 100;
- 4. Amendment to requirement 8(3) to allow greater flexibility in the delivery of the offshore phases.

A Supporting Statement has been provided with the application. This Statement confirms that the maximum size parameters for the development will remain unchanged, for example the offshore development area, number of turbines, rotor diameter, tip height, indicative separation distances etc. will remain the same. The document also confirms that the amendments proposed will not have any greater environmental effects than those assessed by the Environmental Statement. Based on the size parameters of the project remaining unchanged and the environmental effects being no greater than previously assessed, the Councils have no comment to make regarding the amendments proposed to the offshore elements of the scheme.
