# 1. Introduction

The purpose of the Equality Impact Assessment screening exercise is to assess the impact of the emerging Local Plan policies upon different sections of the community.

The Equality Act 2010 requires local authorities to ensure that their plans and policies do not adversely impact upon any particular group. Indeed policies should actively encourage greater equality between different groups. The purpose of the Equality Impact Assessment screening exercise is to assess policies as part of the production of the Local Plan to consider whether they negatively impact upon any particular group. Groups assessed include people of different ages, beliefs, socio-economic backgrounds, disability, ethnicity, gender, sexual orientation, pregnancy and marital status. If the screening exercise identifies that any Local Plan policy has a negative impact upon one or more group then it will be subject to a full Equality Impact Assessment to identify how the policy can be amended so as not negatively impact upon the identified group or groups.

An Equality Impact Assessment was undertaken in relation to the First Draft Local Plan in July 2018 and was published alongside the draft plan as part of the consultation. The Equality Impact Assessment has been updated in relation to the Final Draft Local Plan.

## 2. Methodology

The Equality Impact Assessment is a tool for assessing the potential impact of the Local Plan upon different sections of the Suffolk Coastal population. This screening assessment identifies equality issues that may require a full Equality Impact Assessment or changes to the document. This screening assessment is broken down into five distinct stages:

1. Consideration of the existing context with respect to equality matter
2. Assessment of each policy/proposal in the Local Plan on particular groups
3. Monitoring of effects
4. Languages
5. Conclusions and Modifications.

### Existing Context

Section 3 of this document sets out the existing context and considers the existing baseline for diversity within Suffolk Coastal utilising data from the Census

### Policy Assessment

The policy assessment examines each Local Plan policy in turn to see if it is relevant to any of the following groups:

- Age
- religious belief
- socio-economic status
- disability
- ethnicity
- gender
- sexual orientation
- any other groups
- pregnancy
- marriage

If the policy is relevant to any of the above groups then it is assessed to ascertain whether it would have a positive or negative impact on that group together with an explanation about why that impact occurs. If there is no effect on a particular group then the policy is recorded as having 'no impact'. This does not mean that the policy is not relevant to this group but rather that it does not affect that group in either a positive or negative way.

## Monitoring

If a Local Plan policy is found to have an impact (positive or negative) on any of the groups listed in the Policy Assessment Section it then becomes necessary to ascertain how that impact will be monitored. Reference to the monitoring framework will enable an assessment as to whether the policy is being monitored as to its impact upon the relevant group. The relevant monitoring indicators for the policy will then be listed in this part of the Equality Impact Assessment.

## Languages

The languages assessment considers the Local Plan as a whole and assesses whether the plan needs to be presented in different languages or whether language is a barrier when considering the policies within it.

## Conclusions and Modifications

The conclusion considers whether the Local Plan as a whole impacts upon any social group within Suffolk Coastal and whether a full Equality Impact Assessment is required as a result. The conclusion also identifies whether the Local Plan will require any changes as a result of the screening exercise.

## 3. The Current Position

The information below provides an overview of social diversity within the District. It identifies the different groups included in the Equality Impact Assessment, including those of different age groups and genders, ethnic and religious backgrounds and those with a long term health problem or disability. Information is taken from the 2011 Census.

### Age

The information in table 1 below shows the number of people in each age group, with the youngest being those aged 0-4 years old. This includes the number of people in each age group and the percentage they account for in the overall population. Both the numbers and the percentage of the total population are compared against regional and national figures for each age group. The percentage of people in the age groups of those under 10 years old is perhaps a little below the regional and national figures, but the difference is small and probably not significant. Again the percentages of those in their teenage years are also very similar to regional and national equivalents. However, the percentages of Suffolk Coastal residents in age groups between 20 and 44 are significantly lower than regional and national averages. This suggests that those who have grown up in the District move away and are not replaced by in migration from those of a similar age. The percentages of those in age groups over the age of 45 are consistently higher than regional and national averages, suggesting that the District has a large number of those who are nearing the end of their working lives or who are already retired. It is worth noting that the mean and median ages for Suffolk Coastal are also significantly higher than that for the East of England and England as a whole.

## Gender

The total population of Suffolk Coastal is 124,298, of which 60,663 are male and 63,635 are female (see Table 2, below). Overall the number of males and females is similar for each age group although there are slightly more females overall. Table 3 shows that the number of adult males exceeds the number of adult females under the age of 30. Beyond this age the number of females is consistently higher.

## Race

Table 4 below shows that in 2011 there were a considerably higher percentage of Suffolk Coastal residents who identified themselves as white compared to the East of England and England. In Suffolk Coastal 93.9% identified themselves as white English/ Welsh/Scottish/Northern Irish/British as opposed to 85.3% in the East of England and 79.8% in England as a whole. That said the percentages of those who identified themselves as Irish, gypsies and travellers and or from other white backgrounds were lower than those for the east of England and England as a whole.

## Religion

Table 5 below shows that the percentage of people identifying themselves as Christian in Suffolk Coastal was 63.1%, which was higher than in the East of England or England. The proportion of those who were members of other religions was lower when compared to the rest of the region and the country. Notably only 0.4% of respondents identified themselves as Muslim. This was compared to 2.5% in the East of England and 5% in England as a whole. 27.6% of Suffolk Coastal residents identified themselves as having no religion, which is comparable to the proportion in the East of England but higher than for England as a whole. The proportion of respondents who did not state their religious belief was also slightly higher than for the East of England or England.

## Health and Disability

As can be seen in Table 6 below the proportion of respondents in very good health compared well to Suffolk but was slightly below that for the East of England and England. The proportion of those in good health again was slightly lower than for Suffolk but marginally higher than for the East of England and England. The proportion of those in fair health was slightly above that for Suffolk and England and a bit

higher still than for the East of England. The proportions of those residents in bad health or in very bad health were below that for Suffolk and the East of England and in particular were lower than in England as a whole.

Disability covers a wide range of mental and physical health conditions and is defined by the Equality Act<sup>1</sup> as ‘...a physical or mental impairment which has a substantial and long-term adverse effect on the ability to carry out day to day activities.’ The Papworth Trust<sup>2</sup> has produced facts and figures that show the scale of disability in the UK and demonstrate its impact on both disabled people and their carers. Overall there are 13.3 million people in the UK who live with a disability. On average they spend £550 pounds per month on costs related to their disability. Many of these people face a range of issues in supporting themselves and in their daily lives.

In addition information from the 2011 Census shows that Suffolk Coastal has a slightly higher proportion of residents who are affected by a health condition that limits day to day activities a lot (8%). Only Ipswich has an equal proportion and Waveney a higher proportion (11%). Suffolk Coastal also has a higher proportion (11%) with a health condition that slightly limits day to day activities than any other District in Suffolk except for Waveney (12%). By comparison there are 7% in the East of England and 8% in England as a whole who have a severe limiting health condition. For the East of England and England 9% have a less severe limiting health condition.

The proportion of those providing up to 19 hours a week of unpaid care is 8%, which is the same as Babergh, Mid Suffolk and Forest Heath. However it is higher than in Ipswich, St. Edmundsbury and Waveney. The proportion providing 20-49 hours of unpaid care per week is 1%, which is the same as all other districts, except Waveney, which is higher at 2%. The proportion providing more than 50 hours of unpaid care in Suffolk Coastal is 2%, which is the same as all other districts except Waveney, where the proportion is 3%.

There are 1.8 million disabled people nationally who are living with unmet housing needs. Very often the adjustments needed to enable them to live safely at home are quite simple. The value of adjustments to homes of people aged over 65 is stated to cost £290 million per year.

According to The Papworth Trust's Facts and Figures 2018 publication disabled people experience difficulty accessing different places and services. Most commonly 20% experienced difficulty accessing shops; 15% experienced difficulty accessing cinemas, theatres and concert venues; 14% experienced difficulty accessing pubs and restaurants. This limits the options open to disabled people and reduces their quality of life. In addition it can be difficult for disabled people to access vital support and this is noted as being a particular problem for people from black and multi ethnic minorities.
