



Reason for Decision



Reason for Decision



Reasons for Decision



Reasons for Decision





Purpose of Report

To consider and approve the transfer of the applicable external staff ('TUPE Transfer') into the Council's Housing Maintenance Service.

Options Considered

Not to undertaken the TUPE Transfer. This was rejected for the following reasons:

- It would require a re-tendering exercise and is anticipated to result in greater financial costs than delivering an in-house service.
- It would not enable the Council to develop the range of skills and services provided by the Building Maintenance Team.
- It would limit the Council in pursuing opportunities for trading services of the Building Maintenance Team.

Reasons for Decision



Reasons for Decision


To ensure that car park tariffs, associated fees and charges are set and remain appropriate and proportionate to current demographics, user and budgetary demands.

Title of Report	Lowestoft Flood Risk Management Project – Purchase of Temporary Tidal Flood Barriers
Report Reference	REP1301

Purpose of Report

To grant delegated authority to the Head of Planning & Coastal Management, following consultation with the Cabinet Member for Planning & Coastal Management, to commence the procurement process and to award the tender for the procurement of the temporary flood defence barriers. The temporary defences will reduce the risk of flooding to people, homes and businesses until the permanent flood protection work is completed in 2019.

Options Considered

None. The temporary tidal flood barriers are for use ahead of the completion of the Lowestoft Flood Risk Management Project, which will include a tidal barrier and raised or improved walls. The temporary flood barriers will help to reduce the risk of tidal flooding to people, homes and businesses whilst the project is being completed.

Reasons for Decision

To enable temporary flood barriers to be in place to reduce the risk of tidal flooding to people, homes and businesses in Lowestoft ahead of the worst of the winter weather this year and until the completion of the Lowestoft Flood Risk Management Project.

CABINET DECISIONS:

- 1. That budget provision for an estimated £300,000 for the purchase of temporary flood barriers, to be funded by the Regional Flood and Coastal Committee pending final agreement at their October 2015 meeting, be approved as a new project in the 2015/16 capital programme.
- 2. That delegated authority be given to the Head of Planning & Coastal Management, following consultation with the Cabinet Member for Planning & Coastal Management, to commence the tender procurement process and to award the tender for the procurement of the temporary flood barriers.
