Political Proportionality of Waveney District Council

There were 2 by-elections for the Pakefield and Southwold & Reydon Wards on 12 July 2018. The Pakefield Seat was won by the Conservatives and Melanie Vigo Di Gallidoro was duly elected. The Southwold and Reydon seat was won by the Liberal Democrats and David Beavan was duly elected.

Therefore the current Political Composition of Waveney District Council is shown below, alongside the status at the last meeting of Full Council on 16 May 2018 (the Annual Meeting).

The Local Government & Housing Act 1989 requires that the overall political balance of the Council to be reflected, where possible, in the appointment of Members to Committees and Sub-Committees of the Council (known informally as the political balance rules).

A review of the political balance of the Council's Committees has been undertaken, using a standard formula for this process. The results of the analysis are shown below, alongside the results from the last meeting of Full Council on 16 May 2018 (the Annual Meeting).
