

ADVANCE WARNING LANE CLOSURE – Garrison Lane 2nd February to 27th March 2026



Hello, I'm Michael Rose, Kier Senior Site Manager and I want to share an update regarding forthcoming roadworks necessary on Garrison Lane, as the Deben Fields development progresses. I will be overseeing and managing these Highway Works with our specialist team.

From the 2nd Feb 2026, for 8 weeks, we will have a lane closure in place, controlled by traffic lights to allow us to safely carry out the footpath and driveway works to link our site into the public highways, and allow us to undertake further essential repairs and upgrades.

All driveway access at either end and opposite the lane closure, will be maintained throughout during these works. Traffic management operatives will be on hand during the working day to assist if necessary.

We apologise in advance for any inconvenience caused by these works and will minimise any potential traffic congestion.

LANE CLOSURE PHASING SEQUENCE

PHASE 1: Approximately 02/02/26 – 18/3/26

The west side carriageway (Deben Fields side) of Garrison Lane including the footpath will have a lane closure in place, controlled by two-way traffic lights. To maintain traffic flow, there will be no access on to Garrison Lane from either Cobbold Road or Princes Gardens. Please follow the diversion signage. This closure will be in place 24 hours, 7 days of the week.

PHASE 2: Approximately 18/3/26 – 27/3/26

Lane closure will transfer to the opposite (eastern) side of Garrison Lane to allow all works to be completed. This closure will be in place 24 hours, 7 days of the week.
